#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

1) With liaisons in place, Marsha Plesac recommended we contact the heads of each group/ministry and introduce how we will approach their concerns. Fr. Ben suggested a meeting with the heads of each group/ministry be completed before the start of summer. He also introduced a Parish Life Data Survey pamphlet by CARA (Center for Applied Research in the Apostolate), a company that can help the parish better understand the concerns and needs of the parishioners. If necessary, this is a tool that can be used, in the future.

2) The pastoral council was updated on the progress of the school and parish roof repairs, in a letter from Cheryl Balzer, St. Bridget's bookkeeper.

Chapter Two was read and discussed in meeting with the Chair describing this chapter as “interesting and scary”; Jen James’ favorite sentence in the chapter was on page 33, “Jesus Christ is the perfect intercessor, who pleads for us at the right hand of God”. Tanya Meagher felt after reading this chapter that intercessory prayer is so important in our lives.

Father Ben asked the pastoral council to have Chapters 3 and 4 read by the next meeting to be held on May 9th, 2018.
